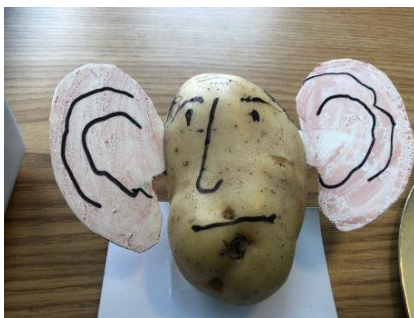
LEGO School Book Tokens
