Free School Meals:

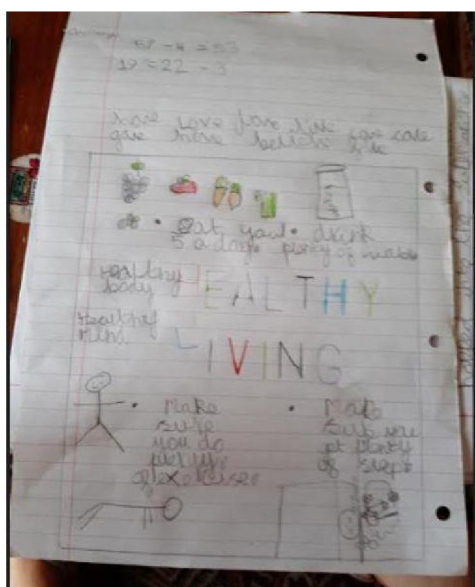

End of Year Reports:

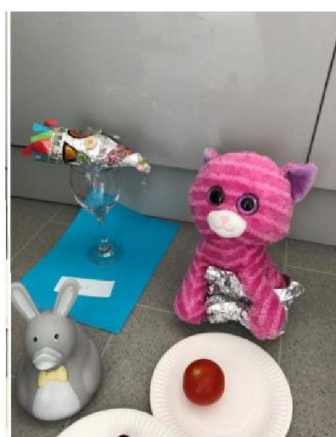
Office staff will be emailing reports directly to families by 14th July. Please ensure we have correct emails for you.

We absolutely love seeing all of your hard work you have been doing at home. Thank you for sending in pictures and keep up the fantastic work!

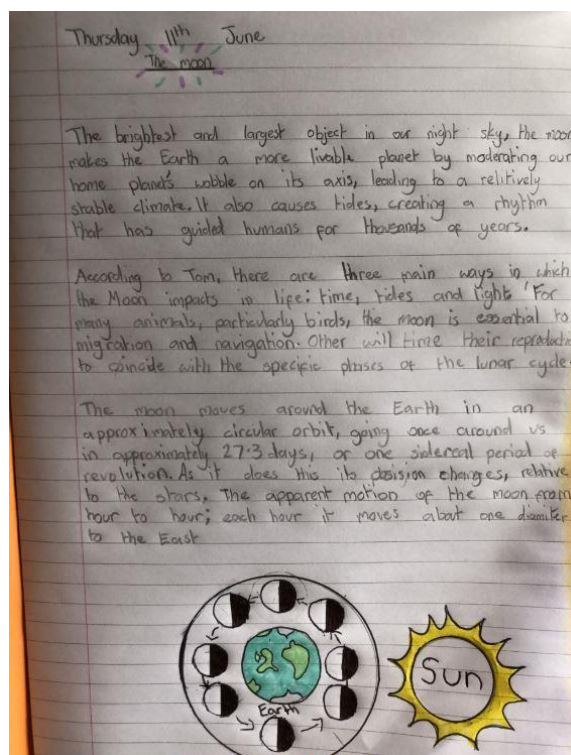

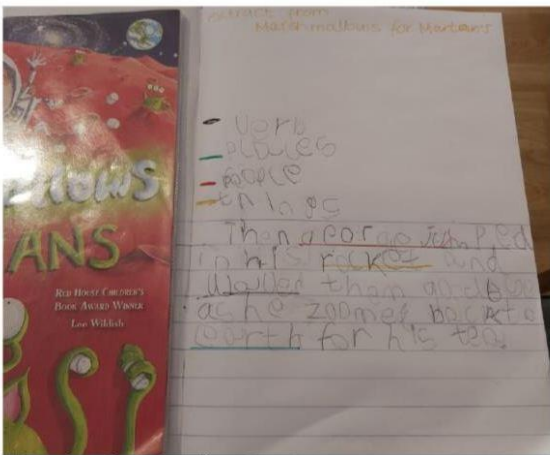
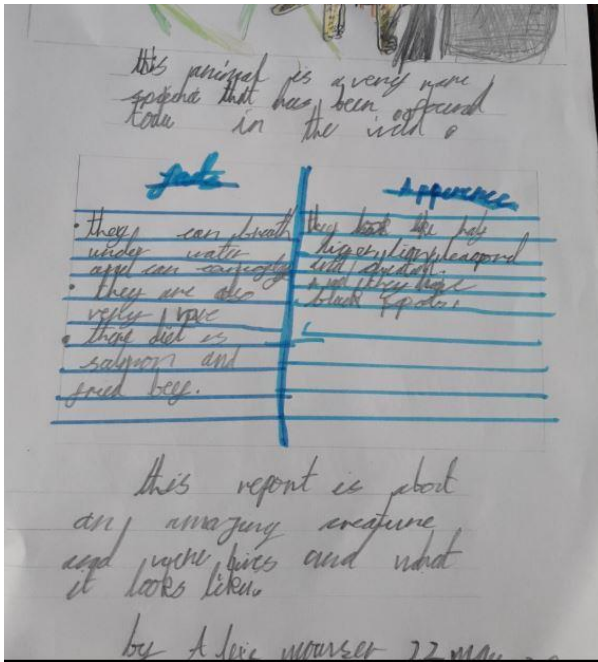
