Welcome to the start of a new school year. I hope you all had a wonderful summer break and we are so excited to welcome you all back!

PE lessons

PE lessons will be on Mondays and Wednesdays and both lessons will be outdoors. All children will need to come to school wearing their PE kits on these days. It is expected that they will stay in them for the duration of the day.

Bringing things into school

Children will be provided with their own set of equipment for when they are in school.

As the weather begins to get colder, children will need to bring in a coat daily and may also bring in a spare pair of shoes to keep in school for when they go outdoors.

Water bottles need to be in school every day. Please can they be filled prior to arrival, and taken home at the end of the school day.

Reading books and home learning

Due to the current Covid situation, library time will be limited. Children will all have time on a Monday to change

their library books. This will be adult-assisted to ensure that they are reading suitable books and to help recommend books that they may enjoy. These books should last them for a week. If they do finish their books before then, they must inform an adult in class who will help them to change it and will recommend a more challenging book.

In their computing lessons this half term, children will be learning how to use Google Classroom. When they are familiar with it, I will be sending their logins home and will begin setting home-learning which they will access via Google Classroom.

At the end of this week, children will be bringing home their guided reading books and will have some chapters to read weekly. It is vitally important that children read these chapters before the next lesson to ensure that they are able to keep up with the guided reading lessons.

Please record reading at home in reading records which should be brought into school everyday. Children should be reading at home with an adult a minimum of three times a week.

End-of-day

As the children are now in upper Key Stage 2, you may be happy for them to walk home alone. If this is the case, then written permission will be required. Letters can be obtained from the school office.

If you have any quick queries, there are always adults from the class available at drop-off and collection times or messages can be sent via the office. Alternatively, you can book a phone call appointment with me via the office.
